Budget Update:

State Inquiry:

Please see attached Letter from the State of Connecticut Office of Early Childhood regarding the possible inclusion in the Federal Preschool Development Grant.

Also discussed was ways to get the word out about preschool options:

- Barbara Wilson will work with Nancy Simmons and David McKenney (IT) about the possibility of linking an
 Early Education Site on our new website so that parents know what prek options are available. We could
 also possibly give information regarding Birth to 3.
- Marilyn Piecuch and Becky Murray stated they feel it's important to get all prek options out on the
 website not just Gilead Hill options. They would like a collaborative website. Becky Murray stated she
 would be willing to help with this. Eric Brody stated he felt that we could only advertise Gilead Hill
 programs...maybe we could consider using the Town website for this?

State of CT Updates:

Marilyn Piechuch stated that there is no new information at this time.

Enrollment:

- We are still at 17 students in School Readiness Program.
- Last month it was stated that we expected to be at 18 but parents backed out.
- Our hope is to have full enrollment by next month.
- Low-income family slot open at this time.
- There should be 7 full tuition and 11 reduced tuition in SR program.
