By-Laws of the Board

STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE

There shall be a maximum of one rotating nonvoting student representative from the Hebron Public Schools 6th grade class. The position shall be shared among four (4) Grade 6 Hebron Public Schools Student Council Members. The Student Representative shall lead the Pledge of Allegiance, introduce the Schools in the Spotlight agenda item and provide a report to the Board. The representative shall not attend any Executive Session or session dealing with personnel or student hearings.

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ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION REGARDING STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Four (4) sixth grade students shall be selected to serve as representatives to the Board of Education.
2. This position shall be shared among four Student Council members. Students shall attend board meetings on a rotating basis.
3. The period of service shall be for one school year and reviewed annually by the BOE.
4. Following their selection, the student representative shall attend an orientation session given by the Superintendent, the principal, and a Board Liaison. This session shall be held prior to the representative's first meeting.
5. The student representative is expected to attend all regularly scheduled meetings of the Board.
6. The student representative shall not attend Executive Sessions.
7. The student representative is not a voting member of the Board of Education.
8. The representative shall stand for all students insofar as it is reasonably possible and shall not use his/her position as a forum to promote individual or non-representative opinions or projects.
9. The representative shall obtain input from and report back to the HES and GHS Student Councils and any other appropriate student organizations.
