We are excited about this new layer of support and the potential for continued growth in our academic intervention program.

District Advancement Plan Measurement

The State Smarter Balanced Assessments are just one measure we use for our District Advancement Plan. They provide a snapshot of student achievement and show valid and reliable measures of students' progress in required knowledge and skills. This year our District Reference Group ranking for ELA scores increased from 18th place in 2019 to 9th place in 2021. In Math, Hebron's ranking went from 9th place in 2019 to 5th place in 2021. The hard work of our students and staff, combined with our investment of resources and recent curriculum adjustments, are resulting in higher student academic performance.



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
