PJ Day for the Kids by Katie Uriano December 11th was the 6th Annual “PJ Day for the Kids” in the Hebron Public Schools. Students and staff made a \$1.00 donation to wear their PJs for the day, raising money for children fighting cancer at Connecticut Children’s Medical Center. This fundraiser originally began in Coventry in 2011 when a second grader came up with this idea while his sister was fighting cancer and a patient at CCMC. Since then, thousands of children in CT have worn their PJs to school and raised over \$1,000,000 for the children at CCMC. Public Act 17-204, signed into law by Governor Malloy, even named the second Friday of December “PJ Day,” officially recognizing the effort. Hebron is proud to have raised over \$1,100 (and counting) this year!
