The Power of the Budget

- The 2022-2023 Budget will continue the work underway outlined in the District Advancement Plan
 - Continue our partnership with Columbia University Teachers College
 - Continue our curriculum development work in Health/Wellness, STEAM, and Social Studies
 - Continue our work in student intervention programs for academics and wellness
 - Invest in Social Studies instructional materials
 - Expand our World Language Program with Spanish to grades 1 & 2

The Power of the Budget

- District Reference Group (26 Districts) Assessment Ranking
 - Reading and Writing: 9th in 2021 compared to 18th in 2019
 - Math: 5th in 2021 compared to 9th in 2019
- STEAM and Challenge Program
 - National Invention Convention First Place in Kindergarten
 - National Invention Convention Second Place in Grade 4
 - State Future Problem Solvers Essay Contest First Place
- Student Enrollment
 - Total enrollment increase of 49 students (7.7%) over two years
 - Magnet school enrollment decrease of 6 students (42.9%) over two years

Budget Goals and Assumptions

- Consensus to continue existing programming with considerations for enhancements outlined in the District Advancement Plan
- Stable student enrollment with more students concentrated at Gilead Hill School
- No increase in preschool tuition rate for 2022-2023
- Continuation of current substitute pay (\$110/\$135)

The Bottom Line

- 2021-2022 Approved Budget \$12,063,673
- 2022-2023 Proposed Budget \$12,546,495
- Total Increase: \$482,822; 4.0%

The Bottom Line – Major Changes

- World Language Expansion: \$29,908; 0.25%
- Increase in Grade 1 Classrooms: \$183,166; 1.52%
- Contractual and other changes \$269,748; 2.23%
- Total increase: \$482,822; 4.0%

The Bottom Line – Major Changes

- World Language Expansion: .4 FTE & instructional materials
- Increase in Grade 1 Classrooms: 2.0 FTE, supplies, & furniture
- Operations: Contractual costs, supplies, transportation,
 & utilities

World Language Expansion – 2 Year Plan

- 2021-2022: Spanish grades 3-6
- 2022-2023: Spanish grades 1-6
- 2023-2024: Spanish grades 1-6 & Sign Language grades 5
 & 6 and possibly French option in grade 6
- .4 FTE needed for Spanish expansion in grades 1 & 2
- .3-.4 FTE needed for Sign Language and French at HES

In-District Enrollment

- Sept 2022: 684 Projected
- Sept 2021: 684 Total
- Sept 2020: 635 Total
- 2 year increase: 7.7%

- Grade 1 2021-2022: 80 Total
- Grade 1 2022-2023: 111 Projected
- Kindergarten 2021-2022: 105 Total
- Kindergarten 2022-2023: 87 Projected
