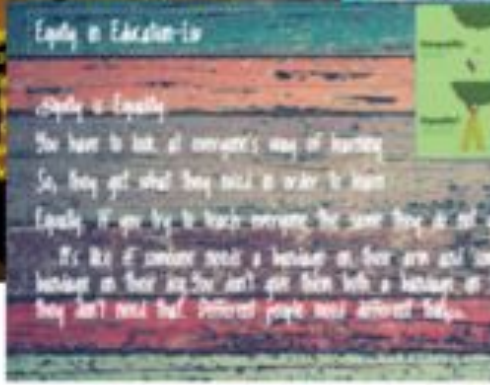
Equity in Education-is

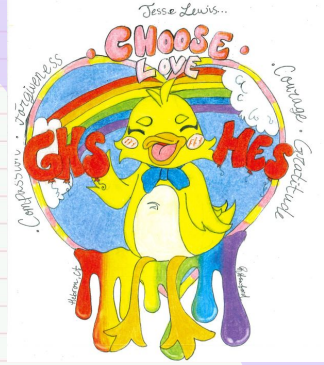
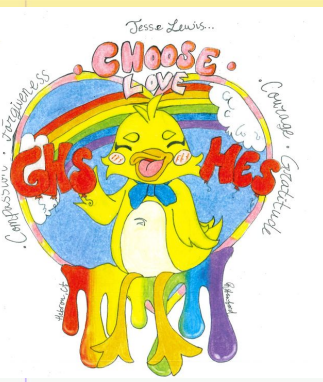

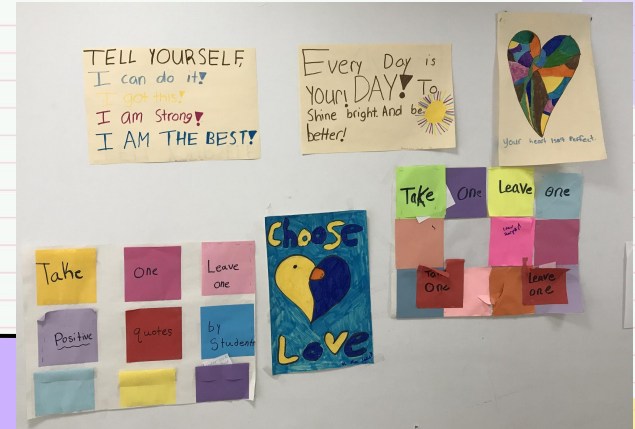
