Climate Survey Highlights

• Certified Survey:

- 97% of Certified Staff feel they have a **positive impact** on their student's achievement and learning.
- 85% of Certified Staff feel **supported** in their building.
- 91% of Certified Staff **enjoy working** in their school building.

• Non-Certified Survey:

- 86% of Non-Certified staff feel they have a **positive impact** on their student's achievement and learning.
- 89% of Non-Certified staff feel **supported** in their building.
- 96% of Non-Certified staff enjoy working in their building.

• Family Survey:

- 92% of families report their child(ren) **feel safe** at school.
- 88% of families report their child(ren)'s **social and emotional needs** are being met.
- 96% of families believe staff have established **positive relationships** with students.
- 93% of families report feeling **proud** their child(ren) attend HPS.
- 68% of families report knowing how well their child is progressing before receiving report cards.

Physical Education Fitness Assessment


Background

- Since 1990, has been an annual assessment of students' physical well-being.
- Grades 4 and 6 in Hebron
- Students are assessed using age standards in four areas:
 - (1) Aerobic endurance; (2) flexibility; (3) upper body strength and endurance; and (4) abdominal muscle strength and endurance.
 - Tests include: Aerobic endurance test (run); Sit and Reach test; 90 degree push up test; Curl up (abdominals)
 - Results are available publicly on the CSDE's data dissemination website <u>EdSight</u>.
 - Annual outcomes are also included in the Next Generation Accountability reports and the Profile and Performance reports (i.e., district annual report card).
